**RESOLUTION ON COMMUNITY-BASED CONTRACTORS
AND ESSENTIAL HEALTH SERVICES**

WHEREAS, ensuring the availability of essential health care services is part of the fundamental responsibility of the City and County of San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, the network of community-based health contractors provide a critical contribution to the Department of Public Health in its provision of these vital services; and,

WHEREAS, the community-based health contractors throughout the neighborhoods are representative of the ethnic, cultural, and linguistic diversity of San Francisco; and,


WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health recognizes that the services provided by the community-based contractors are an integral part of the continuum of health services; and,

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Department of Public Health to treat fairly and equitably services provided by the community-based contractors with those provided by the Department; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Health Commission acknowledges that these community-based services are essential; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health Commission will direct Department staff to seek necessary budgetary support to maintain the quantity and quality of these essential services.
