RESOLUTION NO. 113-88

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE TRANSFER AGREEMENT
WITH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA GOVERNING THE TRANSFER OF STATE OF CALIFORNIA,
DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH, MENTAL HEALTH SOCIAL SERVICES PROGRAM
TO PROVIDE CERTAIN BENEFITS TO THE TRANSFERRED EMPLOYEES**

WHEREAS, Chapter 1330, Statutes of 1984 authorizes the State Department of Mental Health to transfer its responsibility for mental health social services to the counties; and

WHEREAS, the voters of the City and County of San Francisco approved the transfer of the Mental Health Social Services program to the County's jurisdiction in November, 1985 by the addition of Charter Section 3.696.1; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, in Resolution No. 846-87, approved an agreement entitled Transfer of State of California, Department of Mental Health, Mental Health Social Services Program ("Transfer Agreement"), governing the transfer of this program from the State to the County (Board Resolution #846-87, File 400-87-1); and

WHEREAS, the Transfer Agreement does not provide that the transferring employees are entitled to OASDI, health, retirement, vision care and dental insurance benefits; and

WHEREAS, the State of California had indicated its willingness to pay the premiums costs so that the transferring employees may obtain these benefits and to amend the Transfer Agreement to that effect; now, there, be it


RESOLVED, that the Health Commission hereby approves an amendment to the Transfer Agreement to add the following language:

The funding required in Section III of the Transfer Agreement includes a specified amount of money for salaries and wages and staff benefits. The actual amount of funding transferred to the COUNTY for 1987/88 and the amount to be transferred for 1988/89 is displayed in Attachment I. The STATE agrees to reimburse the COUNTY annually for costs in excess of those displayed in Attachment I for OASDI and for retirement and health contributions to the State Public Employees Retirement System on behalf of the transferring employees for so long as any such employees remain in COUNTY service. The STATE further agrees to pay any additional costs in addition to those funds transferred as shown in Attachment I for vision and dental insurance premium coverage for transferring employees as long as such employees remain in COUNTY service. The COUNTY shall have no independent obligation to provide vision care or dental insurance benefits if for any reason the STATE does not pay the fulls costs of the benefits as provided herein.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health Commission hereby directs the Secretary to send a copy of this resolution to the Board of Supervisors with a draft resolution for Board adoption approving the amendment to the Transfer Agreement.
