RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY REGARDING COMPLIANCE OF
THE CONSENT DECREE FOR JAIL MEDICAL AND PSYCHIATRIC SERVICES AND
AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT TO REQUEST EMERGENCY RESERVE FUNDS
FOR THE CONSENT DECREE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION

WHEREAS, the Health Commission has approved a supplemental appropriation request of \$703,000 to fund jail medical and psychiatric services in compliance with the jail consent decree; and,

WHEREAS, The Controller has advised that the requested source of funds for this request be the City's emergency fund reserve; and

WHEREAS, a declaration of emergency is required to use these funds; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission declares an emergency regarding compliance to the consent decree for jail medical and psychiatric services and authorizing the Department to request the City's emergency reserve to fund these services.
