**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF GOVERNOR'S APPROVAL OF AUGMENTATIONS
TO STATE BUDGET FOR FUNDING OF HEALTH SERVICES**

Whereas, the State Legislature has made several augmentations (see attached) to the State Budget that have direct revenue implications for the San Francisco Department of Public Health; and,

Whereas, these augmentations must be approved by the Governor before they can take effect; and,


Whereas, the State's funding of the health services it mandates has been insufficient to support the health care needs of San Franciscans; and,

Whereas, the proposed augmentations apply to several critical areas of health care services, such as AIDS, mental health, services to the medically indigent, Medi-Cal, AB8, immigrants and maternal and child health programs now; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission supports the augmentations proposed by the State Legislature and; be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health Commission urges the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors to urge the Governor to approve these proposed augmentations in their entirety.
