**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SAN FRANCISCO GENERAL HOSPITAL  
TO IMPLEMENT NEW SERVICE RATES FOR FISCAL YEAR 1988-89**

WHEREAS, the new proposed rates are for only major services and surgery and do not include clinics, emergency services, or other ancillary services; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed rates compare favorably with service rates of community hospitals in San Francisco, and in particular with institutions most similar in size and scope as San Francisco General Hospital; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco General Hospital charges need to be more reflective of actual costs, the proposed rates are based upon actual costs of services provided; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed rates reflect the Department of Public Health's desire to maintain a moderate service rate structure; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco General Hospital anticipates an increase in revenue to result from the new service rates; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that San Francisco General Hospital be allowed to implement new service rates to be effective immediately for Fiscal Year 1988-89.
