RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AMENDMENT TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE
AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSION TO EXECUTE HOLD HARMLESS
AGREEMENTS WITH INSTITUTIONS FOR THE REVIEW OF MEDICAL RECORDS
TO IDENTIFY REPORTABLE DISEASES OR CONDITIONS

Whereas, the San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding Section 1.35 to read as follows:

Hold Harmless Agreements Between the Health Commission and Institutions For the Review of Medical Records to Identify Reportable Diseases or Conditions. The Health commission is hereby authorized to enter into hold harmless agreements with hospitals, medical institutions, clinical laboratories and schools when such institutions agree to allow Department of Public Health employees to review their medical and laboratory records in order to identify diseases or conditions required by law to be reported to the local health officer or the State Department of Health Services.

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission approves amending the Administrative Code by adding Section 1.35; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health Commission transmit this resolution to the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor of San Francisco.
