**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AMENDMENT TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE
AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSION TO EXECUTE HOLD HARMLESS
AGREEMENTS WITH MEDICAL INSTITUTIONS PROVIDING
SPECIALIZED MEDICAL TRAINING**


Whereas, the San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding Section 1.34 to read as follows:

Hold Harmless Agreements Between the Health Commission and Medical Institutions Providing Specialized Training. The Health Commission is hereby authorized to enter into hold harmless agreements with hospitals and other medical institutions when such institutions agree, at the request of the Director of Public Health, to provide specialized training in one or more particular medical procedures to Department of Public Health Employees.

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission approves amending the Administrative Code by adding Section 1.34; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health Commission transmit this resolution to the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor of San Francisco.
