**A RESOLUTION ON IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NON-SMOKING ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors enacted Ordinance No. 300-88 to protect the non-smoker from environmental tobacco smoke and to eliminate smoking, as much as possible, in public places; and,


WHEREAS, the ordinance provides that within 90 days after the effective date, the Health Commission shall adopt regulations or policies implementing the provisions of the Article; and,

WHEREAS, the Health Commission is responsible for property owned or leased by the City and County of San Francisco and its employees and visitors; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission supports the regulation of smoking in public places to protect the health, safety, welfare, comfort and environment of non-smokers; and be it further

RESOLVED, that effective October 1, 1988, all management in the Department of Public Health shall implement the requirements of the Ordinance for all buildings and properties under the control of the Department.
