**RESOLUTION ON VD AWARENESS MONTH**

WHEREAS, the spread of sexually transmitted diseases in San Francisco is a serious health concern; and,

WHEREAS, significant increases in gonorrhea and syphilis cases have occurred in San Francisco in association with crack-cocaine use; and,


WHEREAS, crack-associated unsafe sex creates a disturbing potential for increased rates of new HIV infections in the 1990's; and,

WHEREAS, prevention is a proven method to reduce the incidence of sexually transmitted diseases, including AIDS; and,

WHEREAS, public education programs provide accurate information about the dangers of sexually transmitted diseases, and how to prevent contracting the diseases; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the month of April 1989 be proclaimed "Venereal Disease (VD) Awareness Month" in San Francisco.
