**RESOLUTION ON CONTINUED FUNDING  
FOR HEALTH SERVICES DEMONSTRATION PROJECTS**

WHEREAS, Federal legislation dictates that health services demonstration projects are funded on a short-term basis and the Health Resources and Services Administration of the United States Public Health Service implements this policy; and,

WHEREAS, many health services demonstration projects promote out-of-hospital programs, thereby decreasing acute care costs; and,

WHEREAS, there are successful health services demonstration projects that need long-term funding in order to provide continuity in the continuum of care; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission recommends to the Mayor to encourage our Federal legislators to encourage the Administrators of the Health Resources and Services Administration to assist successful demonstration projects in obtaining continuing funds to provide the continuity of care needed in the community.
