RESOLUTION NO. 146-89

**RESOLUTION ON DETERMINING WHETHER THE CLOSING OF THE MT. ZION DENTAL CLINIC
WILL OR WILL NOT HAVE A DETRIMENTAL IMPACT ON HEALTH CARE SERVICE OF THE
COMMUNITY**

Whereas, there is insufficient reimbursement from Medi-Cal for dental services; and

Whereas, the actual costs of running the Mt. Zion Dental Clinic substantially exceeded the reimbursement, thus necessitating the closing by Mt. Zion of its Dental Clinic; and

Whereas, the Commission recognizes that Mt. Zion has made efforts to increase the availability of dental services elsewhere; and

Whereas, there will nevertheless be fewer dental services provided in the Western Addition; therefore,

Be it resolved, that the Health Commission determines that the closing of the Mt. Zion Dental Clinic will have a detrimental impact on the healthcare service of the community.
