**RESOLUTION ON RECOMMENDATION  
TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO REJECT  
A PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT TO CONSOLIDATE  
VARIOUS CLASSIFICATIONS UNDER THE SHERIFF**

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health presently employs Institutional Police within buildings of the Department, including San Francisco General Hospital and Laguna Honda Hospital; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee of the Board of Supervisors has adopted a proposed plan to reclassify all Institutional Police as deputy sheriffs under the jurisdiction of the Sheriff; and

WHEREAS, the proposed plan would disrupt the organization of Institutional Police at each of the hospitals, create administrative confusion, and adversely impact the present security program at these healthcare institutions; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Health Commission recommend to the Board of Supervisors to reject the proposed plan to reclassify Institutional Police presently employed by the Department of Public Health to deputy sheriffs under the jurisdiction of the Sheriff.
