**RESOLUTION TO
COMMEND AND SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT
OF A PROGRAM TO PROVIDE SKILLED NURSING SERVICES
TO PERSONS WITH HIV DISEASE
AT LAGUNA HONDA HOSPITAL AND REHABILITATION CENTER**

WHEREAS, there is a need for skilled nursing services for persons with AIDS and HIV disease in San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, the Blue Ribbon Committee Report recommended that a limited number of beds at Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center be made available to persons with AIDS; and

WHEREAS, Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center staff have decided to dedicate skilled nursing beds to the care of persons with AIDS and HIV disease beginning in January, 1990; and

WHEREAS, exemplary intradepartmental coordination between Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center and the AIDS Office within the Department of Public Health has assisted in this decision; and

WHEREAS, this program is in keeping with the San Francisco model of a continuum of care for persons with AIDS and HIV disease; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Health Commission commends Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center for taking the initiative to develop this needed program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health Commission support this inter-divisional approach to planning, and provide all needed assistance to assure the timely implementation of this new program.
