RESOLUTION NO. 159-89

RESOLUTION ON THE MT. ZION/UCSF INTEGRATION

WHEREAS, the Health Care Planning Ordinance stipulates that prior to a hospital inpatient or outpatient facility leasing, selling, or transferring of management, public notice will be given to the Health Commission; and,

WHEREAS, the Health Commission held a public hearing on December 5, 1989 to determine whether the Mt. Zion/UCSF Integration will or will not be detrimental to health care service of the community; and,

WHEREAS, the Mt. Zion/UCSF integration will preserve a thriving, community-based, acute care hospital with enhanced patient care, teaching, and research programs that will significantly add to the health and well-being of San Francisco and Northern California, as well as to the Western Addition; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission determines that the Mt. Zion/UCSF integration will not have a detrimental impact on the health care service of the community.
