WHEREAS, the Health Commission recognizes and values the special skills of both physician assistants and nurse practitioners; and,

WHEREAS, the Department's employment of physician assistants has been delayed by questions regarding the most appropriate classification for physician assistants; and,


WHEREAS, an independent factfinder has reviewed the matter and recommended a separate classification entitled "physician assistant"; and,

WHEREAS, the Department intends to expedite the processing of this classification in order to employ physician assistants as soon as possible; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission accepts the Fact-Finder's recommendation as to a separate classification entitled "physician assistant"; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health Commission recommends to the Civil Service Commission to establish a separate physician assistant classification.
