**RESOLUTION REGARDING  
NEW FUNDING REQUESTS FOR NEW HOMELESS INITIATIVES**

WHEREAS, the Health Commission in its budget submission to the Mayor's Office for FY1990-1991 designated homelessness as one of its highest priorities; and

WHEREAS, a joint planning committee from the Department of Public Health, Department of Social Services and the Mayor's Office has developed proposed program budgets for two multi-service centers, expanded detoxification and post-detoxification services, an alcohol drop-in center, a new nonprofit housing entity and a new family shelter; and


WHEREAS, medical, mental health and substance abuse services to support those new homeless initiatives would require new General Fund requests in the amount of \$1,011,614; and

WHEREAS, the Health Commission advocates a monitoring process to assess the effectiveness of the new homeless programs; and

WHEREAS, the Health Commission has reviewed the proposed budgets for the new homeless initiatives and finds them to be consistent with the budget priorities it has established; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission approves the inclusion of \$1,011,614 in new General Fund requests for new homeless initiatives into the FY1990-1991 Department of Public Health budget.
