RESOLUTION OF THE HEALTH COMMISSION TO ENDORSE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ORDINANCE TO GOVERN THE PAYMENT OF CLAIMS FROM PHYSICIANS AND HOSPITALS FOR CERTAIN MEDICAL SERVICES PROVIDED TO PATIENTS FROM FUNDS OBTAINED THROUGH THE CIGARETTE AND TOBACCO SURTAX INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Department of Public Health desires to implement the provisions of the tobacco tax and Health Protection Act of 1988 (the "Tobacco Tax Initiative"); and

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Department of Public Health desires to establish procedures for the filing of claims by physicians and hospitals for reimbursement from these funds, the payment of claims to eligible parties, and the recoupment of any funds erroneously paid; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission endorses and encourages the Mayor and Board of Supervisors to support the ordinance governing the payment of hospital and physician claims obtained through the tobacco surtax initiative.
