FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health Commission encourages the San Francisco Board of Supervisors and the Mayor of San Francisco to strongly urge the United States Government to change existing regulations so as to no longer restrict the travel of any individual into the United States based on HIV status thereby conforming with the non-discrimination policy of the City and County of San Francisco and the public health standards of the World Health Organization, Centers for Disease Control and the United States Public Health Service.
