RESOLUTION REGARDING  
QUALITY ASSURANCE/UTILIZATION REVIEW  
FOR THE CHIP HOSPITAL AND PHYSICIAN PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the State of California is providing funding to counties for medical care to indigents through the California Health Care for Indigents Program (CHIP); and

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Department of Public Health is administering this program locally; and

WHEREAS, AB 75 does not include provisions for quality assurance/utilization review for the CHIP hospital and physician program; and

WHEREAS, the Department shall utilize auditing/recoupment procedures to insure provider performance and efficiency; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission approve the policy that the Department shall use auditing/recoupment procedures to guarantee that program goals are met.
