RESOLUTION SUBMITTING THE SAN FRANCISCO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH STRATEGIC PLAN FOR MENTAL HEALTH, SUBSTANCE ABUSE & FORENSIC SERVICES TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS & URGING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO APPROVE THIS PLAN

WHEREAS, Section 15.7-1 of the San Francisco Administrative Code requires that the Department of Public Health and the Health Commission assure the development of a San Francisco Mental Health Services Plan which addresses specific issues; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health, Division of Mental Health, Substance Abuse and Forensic Services, has developed the Strategic Plan for Mental Health, Substance Abuse & Forensic Services in response to this requirement; and

WHEREAS, this Plan describes goals for providing more effective services to residents of the City who are children who are emotionally disturbed, adults and seniors who are mentally ill, substance abusers, forensic clients and forensically-linked victims and mentally ill offenders; and to those in these groups who have special needs; and

WHEREAS, this Plan describes general strategies for achieving these goals; and

WHEREAS, the Health Commission supports both the goals and the general strategies for this Plan; and

WHEREAS, this Plan will be followed by Annual Division Action Plans, describing specific actions that will be taken to implement the strategies, and that Division Action Plans will form the basis of the Division's budget discussions with the Health Department each year; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission approves the Strategic Plan for Mental Health, Substance Abuse & Forensic Services, and transmits the plan to the Board of Supervisors for their review and approval.
