RESOLUTION OF THE HEALTH COMMISSION TO ENDORSE AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISION OF THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO ALLOW APPROPRIATION AND EXPENDITURE OF INTEREST EARNED ON AB 75 TOBACCO TAX FUNDS


WHEREAS, the San Francisco Department of Public Health desires to implement the provisions of AB 75, the implementing legislation for the Tobacco Tax and Health Protection Act of 1988; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Department of Public Health desires to appropriate and expend interest earned on AB 75 funds in the manner required by the legislation and as outlined in the County Health Services Plan and Budget for the City and County of San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Department of Public Health desires to maximize disbursements to local health providers and avoid sending needed health care dollars back to the State; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission encourages the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors to support this proposed ordinance to amend the Administrative Provision of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance which will allow the appropriation and expenditure of interest earned on AB 75 tobacco tax funds.
