RESOLUTION REQUESTING QUARTERLY REPORTS  
FROM CALIFORNIA PACIFIC MEDICAL CENTER

WHEREAS, the Health Commission is responsible for implementing the Health Care Planning Ordinance (Proposition Q) approved by the voters in 1988; and

WHEREAS, the merger between Pacific Presbyterian Medical Center (PPMC) and Northern California Health Center (Children's Hospital) into California Pacific Medical Center became official on June 16, 1991; and


WHEREAS, representatives of California Pacific Medical Center assured the Commission of compliance with the Health Care Planning Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, this merger is an unusual circumstance in that the merger is an on-going process and the impact on services may still be evolving; and

WHEREAS, the Health Commission wishes to keep the public informed in a timely and factual manner; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Health Commission requests that quarterly written reports be submitted by California Pacific Medical Center to the Commission on the progress of the merger and evolving impacts on services.
