WHEREAS, the Irwin Memorial Blood Centers are the first medically sponsored non-profit community blood banks in the United States, founded by the San Francisco Medical Society, and are a regional asset, serving the people of eight Counties in Northern California, including the people of the City and County of San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, over two and a half million units of blood have been donated to Irwin Memorial over these fifty years; and,

WHEREAS, the Irwin Memorial Blood Centers have been leaders in innovations in blood banking and on the forefront of research in making blood an even safer product; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission congratulates the Irwin Memorial Blood Centers for their fifty years of service to the residents of the County of San Francisco and the seven other neighboring Counties; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that it encourages continued community support for this important asset.
