RESOLUTION FOR COUNTY HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Health Commission has reviewed the County Hazardous Waste Management Plan authorized under AB 2948 (Tanner, 1986); and,


WHEREAS, the Plan requires specific actions for the Department of Public Health which expands existing services or develops new programs; and,

WHEREAS, the Health Commission supports the progressive policies and programs to more effectively manage hazardous materials and wastes within San Francisco as outlined in the County Hazardous Waste Management Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the budget of the Department of Public Health generally, and the Bureau of Toxics Health and Safety in particular, includes no programs or available revenues to implement specific actions called for in the County Hazardous Waste Management Plan; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission declares that additional funding support will be required to implement program activities detailed in the County Hazardous Waste Management Plan.
