RESOLUTION NO. 4-91

RESOLUTION REGARDING RECOMMENDATIONS  
OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH FOR COMPENSATION  
OF CERTAIN SPECIFIED EMPLOYEES FOR STANDBY PAY

WHEREAS, the Management Information Services (MIS) and the Bureau of Toxics, Health and Safety Services of the Department of Public Health requires that certain specified employees be available for standby or call back services outside their regularly scheduled work hours in order to provide immediate emergency services; and,

WHEREAS, the Department has determined that its uses of standby pay are pursuant to and in compliance with standby pay provisions of the City Salary Standardization Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, the Health Commission has reviewed the information summarized in the report from Personnel which enumerates the employees requiring approval for standby pay, their classification, pay rate, estimation of project standby hours of use from January 1, 1991 to June 30, 1991, total cost estimates and the need for these services to be provided; and, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission approves standby pay for the enumerated employees retroactive to July 1, 1990; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Health Commission resolution be forwarded to the Civil Service Commission.
