**RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE PROMPT REPLACEMENT OF
POSITIONS VACATED DUE TO EARLY RETIREMENT
(PROPOSITION A)**

WHEREAS, the Department of Health Services provides services vital to the health and well-being of the residents of San Francisco; and,


WHEREAS, the budgeted level of health services is directly related to community demand, compliance with state and local mandates, MOU staffing specifications, accreditation and licensing requirements and revenue targets; and,

WHEREAS, the staffing levels reflected in the approved budget must be maintained if health and safety services are to meet community demands and standards, while generating certifiable revenues; and,

WHEREAS, it is not in the community's best interest to have gaps in or disruption of needed and established health care services; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission urges the Mayor and Board of Supervisors to take any and all actions necessary to expeditiously fill those positions vacated due to early retirement (Proposition A) which are vital to the continuing provision of health services.
