RESOLUTION NO. 11-93

**RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THAT PROPOSITION D,
WHICH PROVIDES THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH WITH
THE ABILITY TO ENTER INTO LEASE FINANCING ARRANGEMENTS,
BE RESUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS OF SAN FRANCISCO**

WHEREAS, the acquisition of medical equipment and capital improvements to facilities is critical to the Department of Public Health's ability to fulfill its mission; and,

WHEREAS, the City and County have very limited budgets for the purchase of capital equipment and funding of capital improvement projects; and,


WHEREAS, the Charter Amendment set forth in Proposition D would enable the Department of Public Health to enter into lease financing arrangements for capital equipment and capital improvements; and,

WHEREAS, such lease financing arrangements would provide a cost effective means for the City and County to acquire capital equipment and capital improvements; and,

WHEREAS, Proposition D failed by only a very narrow margin in the last election; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission recommends to the Board of Supervisors that Proposition D be resubmitted to the voters of San Francisco in the next election.
