**RESOLUTION ON DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH
BUDGET CUTS FOR FY 1993/94**

WHEREAS, the proposed budget cuts in health care would significantly impair the health and welfare of the citizens in the City and County of San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, a number of efforts have been undertaken by the Office of the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors to secure additional revenues to reinstate critical elements of health care provisions currently projected for elimination in the current budget proposal; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission commends and supports the decision of the Mayor to allocate the projected \$24 million which will be secured from Retirement Funds in FY 1993-94 to reinstate health services; and, be it,

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission calls upon the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor to establish a Fire Assessment District and to redirect all General Fund revenues freed up from the Fire Department budget to reinstate health services.
