RESOLUTION NO. 19-93

**SUPPORTING LEASE FINANCING PROGRAM FOR THE PURCHASE OF
AN 800 MHZ. TRUNKING RADIO SYSTEM FOR THE PARAMEDIC DIVISION**

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Department of Public Health, Paramedic's Division's radio communication needs cannot be met with the current equipment and number of frequencies; and,

WHEREAS, the Paramedic Division needs increased communications coverage within the city to perform its functions; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Communications Commission will likely adopt a proposed rule (Part 88) which will require costly modifications to the Paramedic Division's existing system, including immediate partial replacement and eventual total replacement of the system by the year 2004; and

WHEREAS, there are increased demands for information transfer between and with departments, which the current systems cannot accommodate; and

WHEREAS, the need for standardization of radio equipment, as required under Chapter 22a of the Administrative Code, can only be met by changing the current radio system to an 800 Mhz. Trunking Radio System; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission supports the need for a new radio communications system for the San Francisco Department of Public Health, Paramedic Division, and hereby indicates its intent to participate in acquiring an 800 Mhz. Trunking Radio System or other equivalent system; and, be it,

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health Commission hereby agrees to participate in the lease financing program for the purchase of the 800 Mhz. system, as such program is ultimately approved by the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors by budgeting the required lease payments in the fiscal years in which such payments are due.
