**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SAN FRANCISCO MASTER PLAN:  
REDUCING THE PROBLEMS CAUSED BY ALCOHOL AND OTHER DRUGS  
(PART I: NEEDS ASSESSMENT FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS)**

AS PREPARED AND SUBMITTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH, DIVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES, COMMUNITY SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES FOR SUBMISSION TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOL AND DRUG PROGRAMS FOR THE TERM JULY 1, 1993 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1996: AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO SIGN SAID PLAN.

WHEREAS, the planning process has identified the need for interdepartmental training for City employees on the nature and scope of addiction in order to more quickly intervene in providing appropriate services to chemically dependent service recipients; and,

WHEREAS, the planning process has identified the need to enhance interdepartmental coordination and service collaboration between City employees, and between City government and community-based organizations; and,

WHEREAS, the planning process has identified the need to change attitudes and norms about substance abuse through prevention education and advocacy efforts; and,


WHEREAS, the planning process has identified the need to develop a uniform system of data collection within City government and to publish an annual data report for each department; and,

WHEREAS, the planning process has identified the need to develop a service system where treatment upon demand is available such that clients in need are not subject to waiting periods of a month or longer; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission approve the San Francisco Master Plan: Reducing the Problems Caused by Alcohol and Other Drugs (Part I: Needs Assessment Findings and Recommendations); and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health Commission requests the President of this Board of Supervisors to approve said report as required by the State of California, Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs.
