**SUPPORTING SAN FRANCISCO'S FIVE-YEAR
HIV/AIDS HOUSING PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health AIDS Office has determined that there is a shortage of long-term housing linked with services for low income people with HIV/AIDS in San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS; the Department of Public Health AIDS Office, along with the San Francisco Redevelopment Agency (SFRA) have developed a Five-Year HIV/AIDS Housing Planning with the help of the Corporation for Supportive Housing and AIDS Housing of Washington, and extensive input from local HIV/AIDS housing and service providers, housing developers, government officials, members of the Planning Council, advocacy groups, and persons with HIV/AIDS; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission supports the priorities as outlined in this housing plan.
