### DESCRIBING THE GOALS AND ROLES OF LAGUNA HONDA HOSPITAL AND REHABILITATION CENTER MISSION STATEMENT

WHEREAS, the Health Commission wishes to adopt a Mission Statement describing the broad goals and roles of Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center to guide planning, budgeting and policy; and,

WHEREAS, the following Mission Statement has been proposed by Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center:

#### Mission Statement

The mission of Laguna Honda Hospital is to provide or ensure a continuum of health care services for senior and disabled residents of San Francisco.

- o To provide preventive, primary and institutional health care services especially for the poor and others with inadequate access to services, and with priority to those in greatest need.
- o To participate as part of an integrated system of care with the Department of Public Health.
- o To strive for a high quality of life for residents by caring for their physical, medical, emotional, social and spiritual needs with cultural and linguistic sensitivity in a cost-effective manner.
- o To encourage the coordination and maintenance of culturally appropriate community-based health care programs.
- o To foster volunteer participation in community-based and institutional programs.
- o To be a national leader in the provision of community-based and institutional health care services for seniors and the disabled as well as in research and education in the fields of geriatrics and rehabilitative care.
- o To continually evaluate and improve the services provided.
