RESOLUTION NO. 28-94

**DESIGNATING CERTAIN FACILITIES AS INTENSIVE TREATMENT FACILITIES PURSUANT TO WELFARE AND INSTITUTIONS CODE SECTIONS 5150 AND 5250; AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF MENTAL HEALTH TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH SAID FACILITIES**


WHEREAS, Welfare and Institutions Code Sections 5150 and 5250 authorize Counties to designate facilities to provide 72-hour evaluation and 14-day intensive treatment to persons in need of mental health services; and,

WHEREAS, these statutes, as well as Section 821 of Title 9 of the California Code of Regulations, require in addition that such facilities be approved by the State Department of Mental Health; and,

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Division of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services has developed an agreement for these facilities; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission designates Langley Porter Psychiatric Institute, San Francisco General Hospital, St. Mary's Hospital and Medical Center, California Pacific Medical Center, St. Francis Memorial Hospital, Westside Community Crisis, and St. Luke's Hospital as 72-hour evaluation and 14-day intensive treatment facilities effective from July 1, 1994 through June 30, 1997, and authorizes the Deputy Director of Mental Health and Substance Abuse to enter into agreements with said facilities.
