**APPROVING THE AFFILIATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO AND THE
UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA**

WHEREAS, the affiliation between the City and County of San Francisco and the University of California is over 100 years old; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of services by the City and County of San Francisco from the University of California has become an essential component of the public health and the public health system for the residents of San Francisco; and


WHEREAS, the only written and approved Affiliation Agreement between the City and County of San Francisco and the University of California was a five page document executed in 1959; and,

WHEREAS, the missions of the Department of Public Health and the University of California are complementary and it is within their best interest to fulfill their respective missions through an affiliation; and,

WHEREAS, both the San Francisco Department of Public Health and the University of California desire to continue to develop this partnership in a way that is mutually beneficial to both parties, that is focused on efficient, cost effective management, and the provision of a level and quality of care that would not otherwise be possible, that maximizes third party reimbursement, and that holds the parties accountable to one another and to the public at large; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission approves this Affiliation Agreement and further recommends it for approval to the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor of the City and County of San Francisco.
