RESOLUTION NO. 30-94

**APPROVING A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE SOLANO COUNTY
PARTNERSHIP HEALTH PLAN AND
SAN FRANCISCO GENERAL HOSPITAL**

WHEREAS, Solano County has been designated as a County Organized Health System under the State's Medi-Cal program; and,

WHEREAS, the Solano County Partnership Health Plan became effective in May 1994; and,

WHEREAS, between ten (10) and thirty (30) Solano County residents have been treated at San Francisco General Hospital each year; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the advantage of San Francisco General Hospital to become a designated referral hospital for Solano County and to negotiate per diem rates for hospital services provided to Solano County Medi-Cal beneficiaries; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission approves this contract between the Solano County Partnership Health Plan and San Francisco General Hospital, and further recommends its approval to the San Francisco Board of Supervisors and the Mayor of San Francisco.
