**URGING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND THE MAYOR
TO INCLUDE THE REPEAL OF CHARTER SECTION 8.430
IN ANY CHARTER REFORM PACKAGE SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS**


WHEREAS, Charter Section 8.430 prohibits the use of City health and hospital facilities for the provision of employee health services; and,

WHEREAS, charter Section 8.430 was written in 1937 and at that time the Health Department did not bill for services and employees funded their own health benefits; and,

WHEREAS, Charter Section 8.430 is out of date and is inappropriate in today's health care environment; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission urges the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor to include the repeal of Charter Section 8.430 in any Charter reform package submitted to the voters.
