OF THE SENIOR SERVICES TASK FORCE**


WHEREAS, the 21-member San Francisco Senior Services Plan Task Force, created by the Board of Supervisors in 1992 and including seven City Departments providing services to seniors, has developed a Strategic Plan for the future; and,

WHEREAS, the Senior Services Plan Task Force has convened a series of public hearing in five neighborhoods and will appear before seven City Commissions; and,

WHEREAS, the planning process was a collaborative effort with seniors, service providers, advocates, and City Departments to assure older San Franciscans will have access to a continuum of services; therefore, be it,

RESOLVED, that the Department of Public Health and the Health Commission support the concepts in the proposed Plan, which will promote and work towards an integrated, coordinated, consumer-oriented system of senior services.
