**APPROVING RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT
OF PUBLIC HEALTH FOR COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN
SPECIFIED EMPLOYEES FOR STANDBY PAY**

WHEREAS, certain work areas of the Department of Public Health require that certain specified employees be available for standby services outside their regularly scheduled work hours in order to provide immediate emergency services; and,


WHEREAS, the Department has determined that its use of standby pay is pursuant to and in compliance with standby pay provisions of the City Salary Standardization Ordinance or various Memorandums of Understanding; and,

WHEREAS, the Health Commission has reviewed the information summarized in the report from Personnel dated August 29, 1994, which enumerates employees requiring approval for standby pay, their classification, pay rate, estimation of projected standby hours of use for fiscal year 1994-95, total cost estimates and the need for these services to be provided; and, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission approves standby pay for the enumerated employees for fiscal year 1994-95; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Health Commission resolution be forwarded to the Civil Service Commission.
