RESOLUTION NO. 46-94

**PROPOSING RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE JOINT COMMISSION  
HEARING OF OCTOBER 14, 1994 ON THE CHILDREN'S PLAN  
FOR FISCAL YEAR 1995-96 TO THE MAYOR'S OFFICE OF CHILDREN,  
YOUTH AND THEIR FAMILIES**

WHEREAS, the language of the Children's Amendment mandates that an annual plan be developed to delineate the citywide priorities that will drive the expenditures of the accrued Children's Fund dollars; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor's Office of Children, Youth and Their Families (MOCYF) held a Joint Hearing with the Health Commission, Social Services Commission, Recreation and Park Commission, Juvenile Probation Commission, and Library Commission on October 14, 1994 for the purpose of providing input at the beginning of the annual Children's Plan planning process; and,

WHEREAS, Children's Fund allocations have been made for the past three years and services have been provided which have impacted children and families without adequate external evaluation of the funded programs; and,

WHEREAS, an Executive Resolution has been issued by the Mayor mandating City Departments and Commissions, and inviting the SFUSD, private industry, philanthropic organizations, elected neighborhood representatives, service providers and advocates to participate in the development of a citywide strategic plan to guide the expenditure of all public and private dollars servicing children, youth and their families; and,

WHEREAS, the above organizations have been formed as the Children's Collaborative Planning Committee; and,

WHEREAS, the Children's Collaborative Planning Committee has experienced frustration and disappointment in the lack of staff support from MOCYF in the strategic planning process; and,

WHEREAS, input from the Commissioners and the public was given towards the development of the 1995-96 Children's Plan; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission supports the following recommendations made at the Joint Hearing:

- 1) That MOCYF invite the Police Commission, the Art Commission, and the San Francisco Unified School District to future Joint Commission Hearings;
- 2) That MOCYF institute an external evaluation of Proposition J funded programs to assist in service enhancement directing future program allocations;
- 3) That MOCYF institute consistent internal monitoring of programs currently receiving MOCYF funding; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Children's Collaborative Planning Committee present an update of the citywide strategic planning process at the next Joint Commission Hearing; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health Commission request the Social Services Commission, Recreation and Park Commission, Juvenile Probation Commission and Library Commission each adopt a similar resolution to be transmitted to MOCYF.
