RESOLUTION NO. 49-94

**AUTHORIZING THE SAN FRANCISCO DEPARTMENT OF  
PUBLIC HEALTH TO PARTICIPATE IN THE STATE OF  
CALIFORNIA PLAN FOR THE EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE  
PROGRAM ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO TITLE IV-A OF THE  
FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY ACT AND TO CERTIFY INCLUSION  
INTO THE CALIFORNIA CONSORTIUM OF HEALTH DEPARTMENTS**

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Department of Public Health provides health care services to children and families facing medically necessary treatment; and,

WHEREAS, Title IV-A of the Federal Social Security Act provides counties with federal funds for the provision of emergency assistance services to children at risk of removal from the home due to a family member's need for medically-necessary treatment; and,

WHEREAS, under California's TitleIV-A Emergency Assistance Program, eligible health care activities qualify for fifty percent (50%) federal financial participation; and,

WHEREAS, participation in California's TitleIV-A Emergency Assistance Program increases federal support for health services provided to children and families during emergencies by matching local expenditures to federal funds; and,

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Department of Public Health desires to participate in the health component of the State's Title IV-A Emergency Assistance and, thereby, increase federal support for medically- necessary health care services during cases of emergencies; and,

WHEREAS, the California Department of Social Services has direct oversight of the State Title IV-A Emergency Assistance Plan established pursuant to Title IV-A of the Federal Social Security Act and is responsible for the supervising the provision of all services under this program; and,

WHEREAS, the California Department of Social Services will enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the County of Los Angeles as the representative of the California Consortium of Health Departments; and,

WHEREAS, all California counties must certify their inclusion into the California Consortium of Health Departments in order to implement the program on a statewide basis and participate in any federal reimbursement under Title IV-A Emergency Assistance now; and,



WHEREAS, the California Consortium of Health Departments must compensate the State Department of Social Services for program oversight, maintenance of statewide tracking system and staff dedicated to the Title IV-A Emergency Assistance Plan through an assessment fee levied on each county which participates in the program; and,

WHEREAS, each county is eligible for fifty percent (50%) federal financial participation for the yearly assessment costs required for implementing and maintaining the Title IV-A Emergency Assistance Program; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City and County of San Francisco certifies its participation in the health component of the State of California's Title IV-A Emergency Assistance Program and that the San Francisco Department of Public Health is authorized to execute the Certificate of Inclusion for such participation.
