**ENDORING PARTICIPATION IN THE MEDI-CAL MAINSTREAM
PLAN (THE TWO-PLAN MODEL) BY ENTERING INTO A LETTER
OF INTENT WITH PACIFICARE**

WHEREAS, on November 1, 1994 the Commission approved a resolution to support the Department of Public Health's participation in both, the Local Initiative and the Mainstream Plan, of the State Medi-Cal Plan; and,


WHEREAS, PacifiCare is planning to respond with a bid to the State Department of Health Services Request For Application to be the accepted health plan under the Mainstream model; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health has negotiated with PacifiCare for an interim "at-risk" contract to provide services to Medi-Cal enrollees; and,

WHEREAS, PacifiCare wants to include the Department as a provider in its application; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission endorses a Letter of Intent to enter into negotiations with PacifiCare to be a provider in PacifiCare's application to be the accepted health plan under the Mainstream model.
