RESOLUTION NO. 8-94

**SUPPORTING EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES FOR NATIONAL PARK SERVICE, GOLDEN GATE NATIONAL RECREATION AREA ON THE PRESIDIO**

WHEREAS, the Presidio of San Francisco is scheduled to be transferred to the National Park Service, Golden Gate National Recreation Area; and

WHEREAS, once the jurisdiction of the Presidio of San Francisco is transferred to the National Park Service (NPS), the NPS will provide advanced life support emergency medical services within its jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, the EMS Agency medical director for the City and County of San Francisco establishes and maintains medical control and assures medical accountability throughout the planning, implementation and evaluation of the EMS system within his/her jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, the California State EMS Authority, the Health and Safety Code, the California Code of Regulations, and the NPS, Golden Gate National Recreation Area, pursuant to the NPS's Management Policy are each responsible for certifying comparable emergency medical technicians-paramedics in the delivery of advanced life support and other emergency medical services within their respective jurisdictions; and,

WHEREAS, the NPS Management Policies mandate the NPS to assure adequate emergency care and transportation services are available for visitors to the Golden Gate National Recreation Area who are injured or ill; and

WHEREAS, the NPS and San Francisco City and County jurisdictions for emergency care are adjoining; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that NPS emergency medical services shall be authorized to use Base Hospital services and shall coordinate all other EMS services through the EMS Agency pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission approves the Memorandum of Understanding between the National Park Service and the City and County of San Francisco for emergency medical services support; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission urges the Board of Supervisors to approve this MOU.
