**APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE SAN FRANCISCO
MUNICIPAL CODE AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT TO MAKE
THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH A PREFERRED PROVIDER
UNDER THE CITY ADMINISTERED HEALTH PLAN**

WHEREAS, City employees are given an opportunity to choose coverage from a number of health plans; and,

WHEREAS, the City administered Health Plan is one of the few remaining general indemnity plans which reimburses providers on a fee for service basis; and,


WHEREAS, many Department of Public Health staff are desirous of obtaining health services at their work sites rather than traveling to another location; and,

WHEREAS, being included as a preferred provider under the City administered Health Plan will make health services more convenient to Department of Public Health employees, and this improved access to convenient services may lead to new revenue; and,

WHEREAS, the provision of employee health services is in keeping with the Department's Strategic Direction; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission approves this amendment to the San Francisco Municipal Code authorizing an agreement to make the Department of Public Health a preferred provider under the City administered health plan and further recommends its approval to the San Francisco Board of Supervisors and the Mayor of San Francisco.
