**ENDORISING THE FORMATION OF THE SAN FRANCISCO
GENERAL HOSPITAL FOUNDATION**

WHEREAS, San Francisco Charter General Hospital is the safety net hospital for all San Franciscans and provides more services to indigents and the disenfranchised than any other hospital in San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco General Hospital houses San Francisco's only Trauma Center, which provides nationally recognized services to all San Franciscans; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco General Hospital is recognized as the nation's top hospital for the provision of AIDS care; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco General Hospital, in affiliation with the University of California at San Francisco, is highly regarded for the quality of the health care provided and its teaching programs for the future generations of health care providers; and,


WHEREAS, prominent San Francisco General Hospital physicians and community leaders have demonstrated their interest in conducting major fund raising campaigns for the benefit of San Francisco General Hospital; and,

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the provisions of the Foundation's Bylaws, it is not the intent of the Board of Directors to employ or otherwise compensate Board members; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission supports and endorses the formation of the San Francisco General Hospital Foundation, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Public Health Department shall enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Foundation which shall detail mutual obligations.
