**ENDORISING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH,
DIVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH,
FIVE-YEAR SUPPORTED HOUSING PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Division of Mental Health of the Department of Public Health, has underscored the importance of housing in the effective treatment of mental illness in its Action Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the Division of Mental Health has determined that supportive housing is the cornerstone of community support for the mentally ill; and,

WHEREAS, the Division of Mental Health has unique specialized expertise in the provision of support services to mental health clients in housing; and,

WHEREAS, the Division of Mental Health, in collaboration with its consumer population and with interdepartmental input, State Department of Mental Health, and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, has determined the direction and scope of its Five-Year Supported Housing Plan; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission supports the Division of Mental Health's Five-Year Supported Housing Plan, and will support divisional implementation efforts.
