**APPROVING THE REVISED POLICIES AND PROCEDURES  
MANUAL OF THE SAN FRANCISCO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC  
HEALTH HOME HEALTH AGENCY AND RECOMMENDING THE  
ADOPTION OF THE HOME HEALTH AGENCY FEE SCHEDULE  
TO THE SAN FRANCISCO BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

WHEREAS; the San Francisco Department of Public Health received its License from the California Department of Health Services to operate and maintain a Home Health Agency (HHA) in 1986; and,

WHEREAS, the Home Health Agency has provided billable services to the MediCal population over the last ten years; and,

WHEREAS, the Home Health Agency will be piloting home care services to the Medicare population in the Sunset, Richmond and OMI Districts of San Francisco in Fiscal Year 1995-96; and,


WHEREAS, the Federal Social Security Act requires that the Home Health Agency Policies and Procedures Manual be approved by an Agency's governing board; and,

WHEREAS, the fee schedule for the Health Home Agency must be approved by the Health Commission and recommended to the Board of Supervisors for adoption; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission approves the San Francisco Department of Public Health Home Health Agency Policies and Procedures Manual; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health Commission recommends to the Board of Supervisors the adoption of the fee schedule for the Home Health Agency for fiscal year 1995-96.
