RESOLUTION NO. 26-95

**DETERMINING WHETHER THE RELOCATION OF THE URGENT CARE CENTER OF THE CALIFORNIA PACIFIC MEDICAL CENTER (CPMC), PRESENTLY AT THE CALIFORNIA CAMPUS, TO THE PACIFIC CAMPUS EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT, AND THE CONSOLIDATION OF THE CALIFORNIA CAMPUS EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT INTO THE PACIFIC CAMPUS, WILL OR WILL NOT HAVE A DETRIMENTAL IMPACT ON HEALTH CARE SERVICE OF THE COMMUNITY**

WHEREAS, as California Pacific Medical Center (CPMC) continues to address the ever-changing challenges of the new health care era and to adapt their programs and services to meet the needs in the community; and,

WHEREAS, CPMC in monitoring the usage, both by volume and profile, of the California Campus Urgent Care Center and Standby Emergency Department, concludes the necessity for complete consolidation of their Emergency Department by locating the Urgent Care Center contiguous to the Pacific Campus Emergency Department, and to consolidate the California Campus Emergency Department into the Pacific Campus; and,

WHEREAS, the Pacific Campus is 1.8 miles and 7-8 minutes away from the California Campus; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Health Care Planning Ordinance, a public hearing was held on September 19, 1995; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission determines that the relocation of the Urgent Care Center of the California Pacific Medical Center (CPMC), presently at the California Campus, to the Pacific Campus Emergency Department, and the consolidation of the California Campus Emergency Department into the Pacific Campus will not have a detrimental impact on health care service of the community.
