WHEREAS, from time to time, gifts, donations and contributions of money and personal property are made for the general benefit and comfort of the patients of the Department of Public Health; and,


WHEREAS, the San Francisco Administrative Code sets the criteria for the procedures by which all gifts, donations and contributions of money and personal property are to be accepted by the City; and,

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Public Health Foundation, the volunteer organizations at Laguna Honda Hospital and San Francisco General Hospital, and other philanthropic organizations and individuals make gifts, donations and contributions to the Health Department and its Divisions; and,

WHEREAS, the Health Commission recently approved the formation of the San Francisco General Hospital Foundation for the purpose of raising money for projects and programs designed to improve the care and comfort of patients at San Francisco General Hospital; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission of the City and County of San Francisco hereby approves a formal policy and procedure for the acceptance of gifts.
