CORPORATION PROJECT AT 1010 SOUTH VAN NESS AVENUE**

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Health Commission endorsed the San Francisco Five Year HIV/AIDS Housing Plan in 1994; and,


WHEREAS, the Housing Plan prioritizes housing developments that provide affordable housing for HIV-infected residents in a mixed population setting; and,

WHEREAS, the Mission Housing Development Corporation is proposing a development at 1010 South Van Ness Avenue which would provide 30 units, 10 of which would be for low-income persons with HIV/AIDS and would provide access to needed supportive services; and,

WHEREAS, the Mission Housing Development Corporation has a strong history of developing affordable housing in multicultural communities; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission of the City and County of San Francisco endorses the Mission Housing Development Corporation project at 1010 South Van Ness Avenue.
