**URGING THE MAYOR TO ALLOW THE DEPARTMENT
OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO RETAIN INDIRECT COSTS THAT
ARE COLLECTED THROUGH ITS GRANTS**

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health has been successful in bringing significant amount of dollars in outside grants to fund local public health services; and,

WHEREAS, a portion of this grant money is allocated by funders to pay for indirect costs associated with administrating these grants; and,

WHEREAS, it has been City practice to use these indirect dollars to pay for other City and County indirect costs outside of the Department of Public Health; and,


WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health is faced with declining revenues to pay for the current level of services; and,

WHEREAS, these indirect dollars can be used to offset costs incurred by the Department of Public Health in the administration, fiscal and programmatic oversight and evaluation of these grant funded programs; now; therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that the Health Commission respectfully requests the Mayor to allow the Department of Public Health to retain the indirect costs that are collected through grants generated by the Department to offset its costs associated with grant and program management; and, be it.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health Commission requests this for a 3-year time frame and to reevaluate this in three years.
